The Restoration of Two Model Churches

Led by Colin Kerr, Molyneux Kerr Architects

John James's church of St George Hanover Square, London W1 (c.1720) was a model Commissioner's church. William Butterfield's church of All Saint's Margaret Street, London W1, is his masterwork (built 1849-59 with Butterfield additions to 1895) and was a model church for the Ecclesiologists.

The "restoration" of both interiors including glass has just been completed. The Hanover Square church seems little changed; the Margaret Street church is transformed.
